

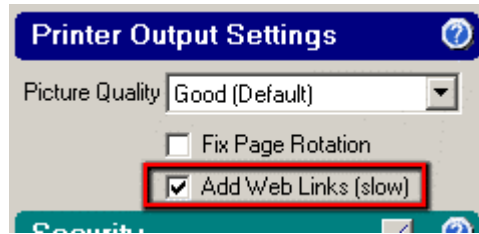

New: Web Links!



- Hyperlinks in the PDF can be automatically turned into a clickable link.
- Limitations:
 1. "Secure Text" must be OFF. (Preferences button >> Security)
 2. Text must use a standard font (either Arial, Helvetica or Times-Roman).
 - **Arial Font:** www.google.com <<GOOD: Standard Font
 - **Tahoma Font:** www.google.com <<BAD: Not a Standard Font
 3. Text that forms the link must be on the same line.
 4. Following links are supported: "http://", "https://", "www.", "mailto:" and "ftp://"

GOOD

BAD

Link is split over 3 lines (broken), so it **will not work**.

Link is "hidden" and **will not work** for security reasons (reader cannot see where link points to).

SPECIAL TRICKS

- You can use a text box placed underneath the text to create the illusion that there is a link. This concept works for text and pictures.

Two text boxes with the link are placed underneath the text. The text color matches that of the background, so that they are invisible.
